

Project Limits



Background Information

- Grading, structures & surfacing in 1955
- Big Sioux River Bridge replaced in 1991
- Last resurfaced in 2008



Highway Deficiencies

- Surfacing age
- Passing sight distance
- Structure life (2 bridges & 3 box culverts)





Traffic

- 2018 Average Daily Traffic (ADT) = 2077
- 2043 Projected ADT = 2960
- > 22.2% Average Truck Traffic



Crash History


- 5 year period from 2014 to 2018
 - 39 Reported crashes
 - 。21 Animal hit
 - 。2 Rear end
 - 4 Angle intersection
 - 。2 Angle no intersection
 - 。3 Fixed object off road
 - 。 1 Sideswipe overtake
 - 5 1 Sideswipe opposite direction
 - 。1 Head on
 - . 1 Overturn off road
 - 。3 Other
 - 9 Injury crashes
 - Reported crash rate = 0.95
- Rural Minor Arterial
 - Statewide weighted crash rate = 1.74 crashes per million vehicle miles of travel



Proposed Improvements

- Construct 2 lanes with 8' shoulders
- Add left turn lane at 475th Ave. (Union County Hwy 25)
- Realign intersection of 297th St. & 486th Ave.
 - Left turn lane at center of curve
 - Existing connections removed
- Replace pipe culverts, box culverts, & bridges
 - Excluding Big Sioux River bridge
- Exception for intersection of SD Hwy 11
 - This work was completed in 2017







Access Management

- To provide safe, efficient access to streets and highways
- Limit number of direct accesses to major roadways



Right of Way (ROW)

- Existing width 150 feet
- Purchase additional as needed for culverts, erosion protection, & fill slopes
- Temporary easements as needed for construction



Encroachments

- Encroachments Private property located within the public ROW
 - Federal Highway Regulations
 - Safety
- Examples of encroachments
 - Signs
 - Private Use (Parking)
 - Landscaping Items
- Owners of encroachments will be notified by the Yankton Area Office



Utility Coordination

- Some utilities may need to be relocated
- Utility companies may negotiate easements with landowners as needed

 - Endangered & Threatened Species None expected




Construction Traffic Control

- Local traffic and emergency vehicle access will be maintained
- Through traffic will be detoured to alternate routes
- SD46 will likely be closed to through traffic during construction

Landowner Meetings

- Fall of 2019
 - Affected property owners will be contacted by SDDOT to schedule an appointment
- Held with individual landowners adjacent to the project
 - Driveway location/width
 - Fences
 - Drainage
 - Trees
 - Temporary easements or ROW acquisition




Tentative Project Schedule

ROW Acquisition Process	2020-2021
Construction	2022-2024
Estimated Cost:	\$32.3 million (Includes Final Surfacing)
